



Imre Környei
1930 - 1993

Imre Környei was born on 11 May 1930 in Zagyvaróna, in a small village close to Salgótarján. He got a master degree as a secondary school teacher in mathematics and physics at the Eötvös Loránd University in 1952. As a senior student he worked at the Mathematical Institute as a demonstrator.

After finishing the university, for the invitation of Professor Paul Turán who was the head of the Algebra and Number Theory Department, he became an assistant at this department. In 1963 he was nominated as a principal assistant. In 1964 he got a new job at the Computer Center of the Karl Marx Economical University as a research worker, and later as principal research worker. He became a titular associated professor at the university. From 1985 he became a vice director of the Computer Center of the Eötvös Lóránd University. Getting a serious illness he retired in 1993, and died soon after that.

Imre Környei was a well-educated expert in different branches of mathematics: number theory, differential equations, numerical analysis, fractal geometry.

He helped several students to start with their research work and supervised them in writing the theses for doctorate and Ph.D. degree.
