Professor Emeritus Zoltán Daróczy's 85th birthday

Professor Zoltán Daróczy as a leader of the functional equations school in Debrecen set many colleagues and students up in their scientific career. As an academician, he played a significant role in Hungarian mathematical public life. He was also instrumental in mathematical life as a professor, head of department, institute director, rector and director of the Doctoral School at the University of Debrecen (formerly Lajos Kossuth University) and its Institute of Mathematics. He was a member of parliament between 1990 and 1998.

His mathematical work is related to the fields of functional equations and inequalities, mean values and information theory, in which areas he achieved decisive results and initiated new research directions. These include, for example, the investigation of interval-filling sequences, during which he published several joint papers with Imre Káta, among others. Many awards and honors surround his life journey.

Professor Zoltán Daróczy celebrated his 85th birthday on the 23rd, June, 2023, during the 57th International Symposium on Functional Equations, which was dedicated to that occasion. He passed away on the 12th, September, 2023. May his soul rest in peace.
