Professor Imre Kátai is the founding editor-in-chief of our journal, *Annales Univ. Sci. Budapest., Sect. Comp.* As a result of his effective and versatile management and organizing activities, the journal provided publication opportunities to the Hungarian and international mathematical community in several important areas.

His mathematical work is related to number theory. His main research area is analytic and probability number theory, in which he achieved his most important and profound results.
